

Education Volunteer Role Description

What will I be doing?

- Ń To deliver practical hands-on living history activities linked to the National Curriculum to groups of KS1 and KS2 (Primary school age) children as directed and supervised by the Cathedral's Learning Officer.
- Ń Occasional weekdays from 9-3 to cover school visits
- Ń Term time only

What skills do I need?

It is essential that you have:-

- Ń An interest in the history of Sheffield and its Cathedral
- Ń Enjoy working with children
- Ń Regular availability - usually we get several weeks' notice of a school visit although occasionally schools book in at short notice.

We would prefer you to have:-

- Ń Experience of working with children e.g. teaching, teaching assistant, volunteer in schools.

Training will be given in session content and classroom technique.

Following our usual volunteer recruitment process, an enhanced disclosure and barring service will be carried out prior to your commencement in this role.

What will I gain?

- Ń Excellent experience for anyone thinking of pursuing a career in education, who has worked in schools and wishes to maintain their skills or who is thinking of working or volunteering in the heritage sector.
- Ń Experience of volunteering in a high-profile role at one of Sheffield's most important heritage sites and one of the most important religious buildings in the country.
- Ń Membership of a team of volunteers committed to providing the best possible experience for visitors to Sheffield Cathedral.
